About ICoN

ICoN - Italian Culture on the Net

ICoN is a consortium of Italian universities that promotes the Italian language and culture through **e-learning**. It works in agreement with the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs and is present in over 80 countries around the world.

The online degree course in Italian language and culture for foreigners

The Degree Course in Italian Language and Culture is a **three-year course** provided online by the ICoN Consortium on behalf of member universities, active since 2001.

The course, intended for **foreign and Italian students, residing abroad**, offers a solid basic preparation in the disciplines of the Italian humanities area and has allowed students residing in over 70 countries to obtain a first level degree completely equivalent to a degree obtained from an Italian university.

Examinations take place through web-conference at educational centres abroad. In Sydney, the **Marco Polo – The Italian School of Sydney** is an appointed centre. Since 2001, over 360 students from over 60 countries in all continents have graduated.

The first level University Masters

The Masters of the ICoN offer are **professional courses** that prepare the trainees to work in the areas of **Italian teaching, specialised translation** and the **protection and enhancement of the Italian cultural heritage**.

Conceived as a continuation of the three-year degree course in Italian language and culture, the ICoN Masters are also open to trainees from other courses and are delivered **online**, with short periods of face-to-face **lessons**.

Training courses for teachers

The training and refresher courses for teachers are born in the context of agreements with **international bodies and institutions**, which turn to ICoN to flexibly satisfy the training needs of **Italian teachers** from all over the world.

The training is carried out **completely online** or in **blended learning**, a method that includes a part of online teaching and a part in attendance.

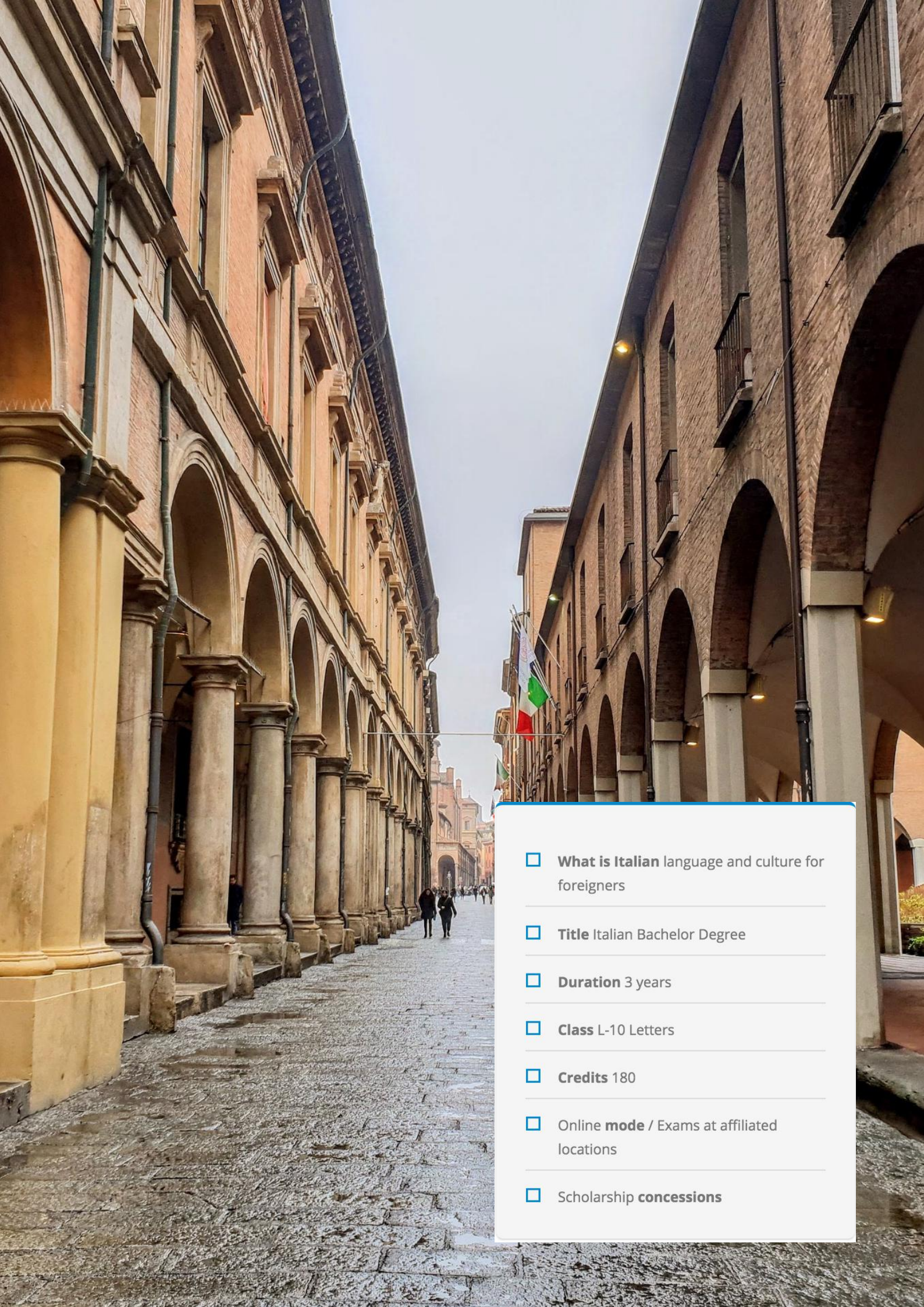
Italian language courses

The ICoN online Italian language courses are designed by **experts in teaching** the Italian language and offered with **flexible** and **customisable** formulas. The training philosophy shared by these courses is inspired by the principle of learning by doing, that is, "learning through the activities carried out".

The core of the offer is the **basic courses** corresponding to the six levels (A1-C2) of the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages*, which can be used both in **e-learning** and in **self-learning** or as **digital texts** for the class in attendance.

The basic courses are accompanied by **specific educational products** for different profiles, for example private students, **high school students** and **university students**, which ICoN delivers by establishing partnerships.

The ICoN Degree

The Degree in a nutshell

Students enrolled in the **three-year degree course** in Italian language and culture can choose from one of four majors (Curriculum):

Arts, music, entertainment

This curriculum includes courses aimed at the arts, music, theater and cinema sectors.

Didactic-language

This curriculum includes targeted courses concerning the field of linguistic and glottodidactic disciplines.

Literary

This curriculum includes courses aimed at deepening the literary and literary criticism aspects of Italian culture.

Historical and cultural

This curriculum includes courses that deepen the Italian language and culture declined in society, politics and economics.

Delivery is entirely **online**. Tutored students attend virtual classes, in which the tutor illustrates the teaching materials and facilitates learning, moderates the discussion in the forums, proposes and corrects the verification tests, guides the students in the didactic path.

The virtual classroom is a meeting point for students from all over the world, who can share their experiences and exchange ideas during their studies. Alternatively, it is possible to choose to study in self-learning, or autonomously, according to the rules of the degree program.

Semester exams take place at affiliated locations. For Sydney, the **Marco Polo – The Italian School of Sydney** is an appointed centre. Visit cnansw.org.au/cna-marco-polo-school.htm for information about the exam centre. The final exam consists of a written or multimedia essay on a topic related to the study path.

Each of the 20 teachings that make up the various curricula corresponds to a university exam. A course comprises a variable number of ICoN teaching modules and includes an exam at the end of the semester.

The **recipients** of the degree course

The Italian Language and Culture for Foreigners course is reserved for foreign students and Italians who are resident abroad. To enrol students must:

- have a secondary school qualification that allows enrolment in an Italian university, obtained at the end of at least 12 years of schooling
- not be enrolled in another Italian university
- have obtained a mark of not less than 60/100 in the language test presented during the enrolment procedure

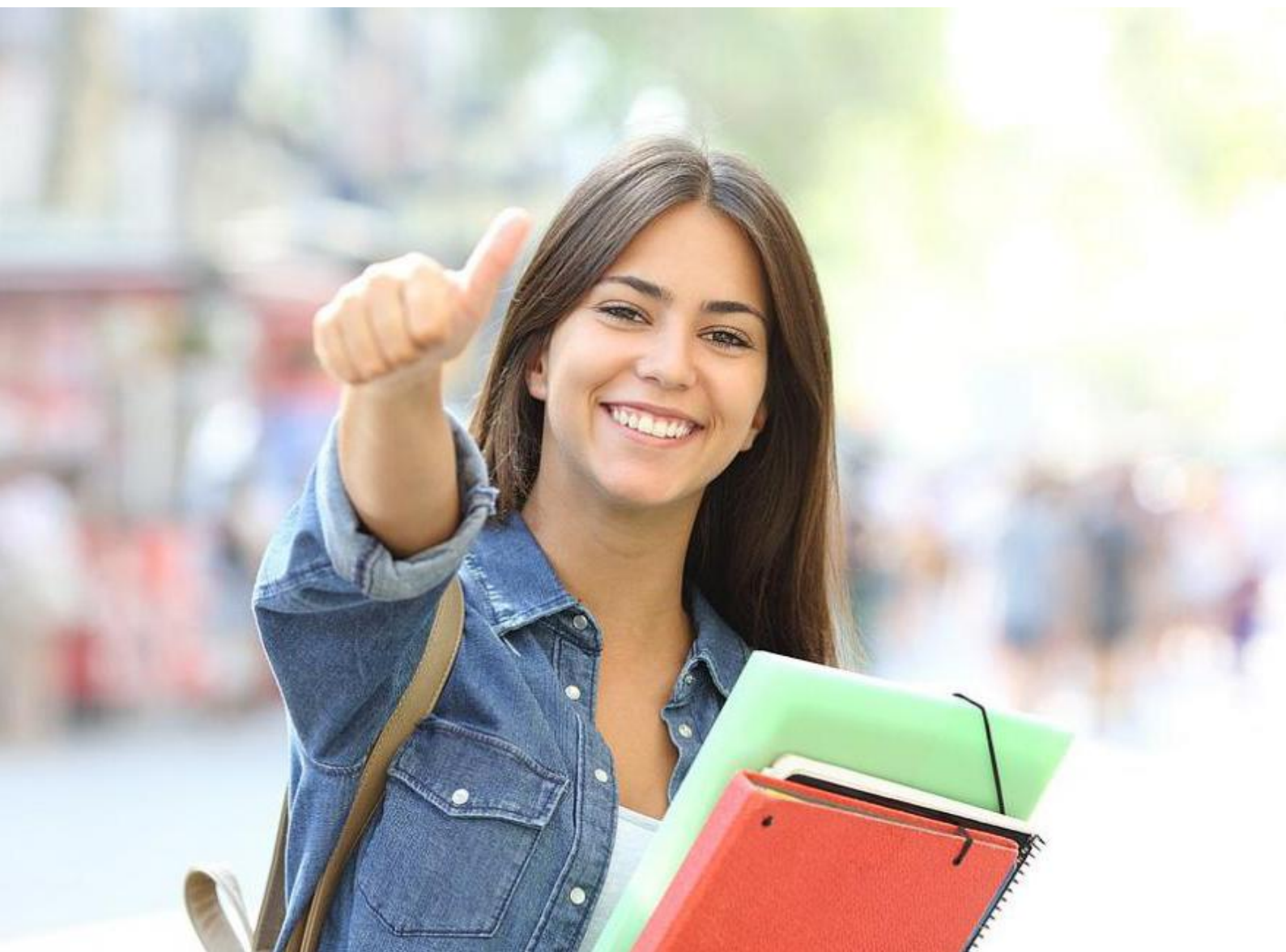
To attend the course, it is strongly recommended to have an adequate knowledge of the Italian language and a sufficient

familiarity with the web navigation tools.

Foreign students can certify their knowledge of the Italian language through a B2 level certification of the CEFR (*Common European Framework of Reference for the knowledge of languages*). Students who are not in possession of this certification must follow the appropriate course of "*Linguistic Insights*".

Foreign students who have obtained the high school qualification in Italy and native speakers must not certify their knowledge of the Italian language.

The course is suitable for those who cannot attend a similar course in their country of residence and need to study at their own pace and time.

In the Italian university system, students' work is measured in **credits**. Each credit is worth 25 hours of student work, which can be engaged in classroom activities, individual study, didactic tests, exercises. **180 credits** are required to achieve a degree, spread over 3 years (on average 60 credits per year). The course is organised into two semesters starting in March and September of each calendar year.

The semester

The semester starting in March covers the months **from March to June** and ends with an **exam** session scheduled between **June and July**. The semester beginning in September covers the months from **September to December** and ends with an **exam** session scheduled between **January and February**.

Each semester, students can still choose to follow more courses than in the study plan and obtain further credits, or less courses and obtain a lower number of credits, depending on their personal availability of time. It follows that students can obtain **180 credits** in exactly three years, or in a shorter or longer period of

time.

It is possible to attend courses in advance of the following semester in the mode preferred by the student, while respecting the prerequisites of the courses.

The final test of the degree

After passing all the exams, the student takes the final test: a thesis on a topic agreed with a professor from a partner university to be carried out with the guidance of a tutor. The thesis is discussed in the presence or in a web conference and is evaluated by a commission of teachers. Graduation sessions take place in May and November each year.

The final mark is expressed in one hundred and ten with the possibility of "praise," and takes into account the results obtained in the exams and the evaluation of the thesis.

The qualification is issued by the **University of Pisa** and sent to the student by the ICoN Consortium.

The course study materials

The ICoN teaching modules are written by authors belonging to the main Italian universities and institutions, mostly university professors and researchers specialised in the various disciplines.

The distance education proposed by the degree course is based on the use of teaching materials which have not only the task of conveying the contents, but also that of clarifying the objectives and structure of the teaching intervention. In fact, the distance

education student needs to understand, the training pathway, at what point of the educational path the student is at, what is the objective of the activities that are proposed, the level of progression of knowledge regarding course content.

The structure of the modules

Each ICoN module has a fixed structure and consists of seven chapters (**teaching units**), divided into five paragraphs (**teaching sub-**

units). To facilitate students' orientation as much as possible, some textbooks are added to the text of the actual lessons: **presentation** , **index**, **guide** (which indicates the general purpose of the module, the objectives to be achieved, the contents, the activities that student must complete the complementary materials to be consulted for further information), **bibliography** and **sitography**.

Each module is completed by an evaluation section consisting of the automatic correction **exercises** (single answer test, multiple answer etc.), with which the student will have to measure himself to verify the acquisition and learning of the module contents. In the first four semesters there are exercises at the end of each teaching unit and summary exercises for the entire module; in the last two semesters, when students have become familiar with the study method, only the summary exercises are present. The results of the tests are automatically communicated to

the student and recorded on the site to keep track of his progress.

Each module is then accompanied by **in-depth multimedia materials** such as:

- images
- audio and video files, such as playing music tracks or speech recordings
- encyclopedic entries, which deepen topics of general interest
- fact sheets, which clarify and complete the contents of the module
- texts with paraphrases
- anthologies of critical essays
- chronological tables, glossaries, synoptic tables, architectural tables

The ICoN modules therefore form the basis of the teachings, which in turn form the didactic paths or curricula.



Fees and scholarships

During the enrolment procedure for the degree course, the student can enrol in the first semester (1/I) by choosing one of the two available delivery methods (*tutoring/tutorato* OR *self-learning/ autoapprendimento*) by paying the relative enrolment fee.

This procedure also applies to enrolment in the semesters subsequent to the first (re-enrolment).

Registrations out of course

It is possible to enrol in the off-semester courses only in self-learning mode.

Those who enrol in the semesters out of course and have yet to take exams will have to pay a fee of **€300** until they are completed. Those who enrol outside the course and have finished the exams will have to pay a fee of **€170**.

Reduction of registration fees and scholarships

Reductions in the half-yearly fee start from enrolment in the 2nd year, for students who have reached the merit criteria set by the Consortium (See the "**Merit criteria**" section).

Scholarships are available: calls are published before the start of each semester.

Bonus exams

Each enrolled student has at his disposal six "**bonuses**" aimed at repeating the final exams that have not been passed without additional expenses. Whenever the student fails an exam, the system automatically scales a bonus.

When the bonuses are used up, the student will be able to repeat the failed exam only by

paying the **€120** fee for each exam to be repeated upon re-enrolment.

Early advancement

Enrolled students can decide to attend courses in the following semester in advance. The cost to attend tutoring is **€130** for each course; the cost for self-study attendance is **€70** for each course. Attending tutoring is however possible if the class was activated in the semester.

Virtual classes

Even students not enrolled in the degree course can attend individual virtual classes (Italian linguistics and history of the language, Italian literature, geography, art history, etc.), at a cost of **€130** for each individual class.

Bachelor's degree certificate

The Consortium will send the certificate to graduates upon payment of a **€50** admin fee.

Method of payment of the registration fee

The registration fee can be paid in a single payment at the end of the registration procedure for the semester or in multiple installments.

Registration for the first semester

- 20% deposit at the end of the registration procedure.
- 1st installment of 40% by the start date of the semester.
- Balance of 40% within two months of the start of the semester.

Re-enrolment in subsequent semesters

- 1st installment equal to 50% at the end of the re-enrolment procedure.
- Balance of 50% within two months of the start of the semester.

Terms of payment

- **PayPal or credit card.** At the end of the enrolment procedure, it will be possible to pay the entire fee or an installment through PayPal directly: the student can choose whether to use the Paypal account or credit card. To pay after the enrolment

procedure, the student can access the payment from his personal area in the "Payments" section.

- **Bank transfer:** account in the name of the ICoN Consortium - Banca di Pisa and Fornacette Branch of Calcinai (PISA) - Swift Code: BCCFIT33 - IBAN Code: IT48M0856270911000010884385 - Reason: degree registration + student surname.

The Consortium will issue a regular invoice after payment.

You are not entitled to any refund after fifteen days from the first registration, and in no case in the following semesters.

The ICoN regulation provides that the student must always be on par with enrolments and payments in order to attend classes and undertake exams.

- Click on the link "Register now!" and enter the requested data
- Activate your account by clicking on the link that arrived to you via email
- Access the Personal Area through the "Login" button on the website www.icon-laurea.it

Self-certification and language test

- Fill in the self-certification form and click on "Continue"
- Click on "Take the language test" and try the quiz. To pass it you must get a score of 60/100. You can retry the quiz as many times as you want
- Once you pass the test, go back to your personal area and click on "Continue with registration"

Registration / 3

Enrolment without scholarship

- Click on "Proceed without scholarship" in the drop-down menu that you will find on the screen following the language test and then on "Continue"
- Read the notice on sending documents and click on "Continue with registration"
- Choose the curriculum to enrol from among the four made available by the degree course and click on the "Confirm enrolment" button

Enrolment with scholarship

- Click on the "Proceed and apply for scholarship" item in the drop-down menu that you will find on the screen following the language test and then on "Continue"
- Read the notice on sending documents and click on "Continue with the application"
- Send the documents you find at the link <http://www.icon-laurea.it/it/borse-di-studio> through the "Send documents" section of the Personal Area
- Wait for the outcome of the selection. You will be notified via email and in your Personal Area

- Once you have obtained the result, both positive and negative, select "Degree" from the menu above and click on "Complete and / or complete the enrolment in the ICoN Degree Course"
- Click on "Complete registration"
- Choose the curriculum to enrol from among the four made available by the degree course and click on the "Confirm enrolment" button

Sending documents

- Periodically check any messages or notes from the secretariat, to make sure that the exchange of documents is successful

Registration for the first semester

- From the "Semester registration" section click on the "Proceed to semester registration" button
- Choose the courses you want to follow and in what way (tutoring or self-learning) and click on "Continue with registration"
- Select the additional courses and if you want to follow them in tutoring or self-learning and click on "Continue with registration"
- You will be directed to a page of "Summary of recovered or anticipated courses", click on "Confirm your choice and continue" if you want to continue or on "Go back to the previous step" if you want to select other exams
- You are now on the "Registration Summary" page where you will find a summary of the selected courses and the cost to be paid (if due)
- Click on "Payment in a single solution" or "Payment in installments" to choose the payment method you prefer

Choose between bank transfer within 5 working days or payment by credit card or PayPal to complete the registration procedure





Re-enrolment in the semesters

For re-enrolments in the semesters subsequent to the first, after the online publication of the results of the end-of-semester exams, the Didactic Secretariat contacts the students by email, providing the indications for re-enrolment.

Re-enrolment in progress

Re-enrolment in progress for a semester
Students enrolling in a new semester of the degree course must:

1. access your own reserved area **during the periods in which the re-registration procedure is active** (will be notified by the Didactic Secretariat)
2. start the re-enrolment procedure (*Register button for the semester of the Degree Course*)
3. choose the study method (tutoring or self-study)
4. contact the Didactic Secretariat (infodidattica@italicon.it) if you choose to accelerate one or more courses from the previous semester

5. pay within one month of the start of the semester

Re-enrolment out of course

A student who enrolls out of course for a semester of the Degree Course **can do so only by choosing the self-learning mode**. In this case he must:

1. access your own reserved area during the periods in which the re-registration procedure is active (will be notified by the Didactic Secretariat)
2. start the re-enrolment procedure (*Register button for the semester of the Degree Course*)
3. contact the Didactic Secretariat (infodidattica@italicon.it) asking which courses to activate among those still to be attempted
4. pay within one month of the start of the semester



Documents and deadlines

Documents required and enrolment deadlines

The documents to be sent vary according to the country in which the secondary school qualification was obtained.

Case 1: The qualification was obtained at a school within the **Italian legal system** ("maturity exam")

Case 2: The qualification was obtained at a school in a country of the **European Union**

Case 3: The qualification was obtained at a school that is part of the legal system of a country **not belonging to the European Union**.
Eg. **Australia**

***See below for specific documents.**

If you have applied for enrolment in the semester starting in March, you must send them by **30 April**, if you enrolled in the semester starting in September, you must send them by **10 November**.

Request for recognition of credits for the abbreviation of the degree course

If you have taken other certified university exams, you can request the recognition of previous credits from the Scientific Didactic Council, through the "Recognition of exams" procedure, present in the Personal Area.

The Scientific Didactic Council deliberates this recognition. In the following days, the Didactic Secretariat communicates the resolution to the interested parties with an e-mail message to be considered an official document.

Switch to another educational path

If you are a first-year student, you can decide to switch to a different educational path (or curriculum) than the one chosen at the time of enrolment. In this case you must submit a formal request to the Scientific Didactic

Council, together with the exam questions for the 1st or 2nd session of the 1st year. The Board deliberates on the passage and then reserves the right to consider the situation of the credits acquired, so as to assess the activity already carried out as a whole.

There is no more than one transition to another educational path, and in any case this procedure, reserved for first year students, will no longer be allowed once the first-year official exam sessions have ended, except in exceptional cases to be submitted individually to the Scientific Council didactic.

Applications should be sent to the ICoN Consortium's didactic secretariat by e-mail at infodidattica@italicon.it.

The possibility to modify the tutoring courses chosen at the time of enrolment in the semester is granted, provided that these changes are communicated to the Didactic Secretariat (infodidattica@italicon.it) no later than 15 days from the beginning of the semester (i.e., normally, by **15 March** or **25 September** of each year).

Case 1: The qualification was obtained at a school within the **Italian legal system** ("maturity exam")

You must submit:

- Application Form (**Form C**)
- 2 photographs, one of which authenticated by the Italian Embassy, or Consulate) in your country of residence (your residential address must also be indicated in the authentication document)
- photocopy of a valid identity card

- any other documents necessary for the acceptance of the application and/or the abbreviation of the degree course.

Case 2: The qualification was obtained at a school in a country of the European Union

- original (or photocopy **authenticated** by the Italian Embassy or Consulate in the country where you obtained the diploma) of the final title substitute certificate of secondary school studies, with relative legalisation, official translation in Italian, by the Italian Representation in the country where you have secondary school qualification
- **Declaration of Value** of the qualification, issued by the competent Italian Embassy or Consulate in the country where you obtained your secondary school qualification
- photocopy of a valid **identity card**
- certification of knowledge of the Italian language at least B2 level of the CEFR

(*Common European Framework of Reference for the knowledge of languages*), not required for those who are Italian native speakers; if you do not have a certification you will have to follow a **supplementary course** ("Linguistic insights") during the course of study

- any other documents necessary for the acceptance of the application (if the secondary school qualification has been obtained at the end of a period of less than 12 years of schooling, send a certificate certifying the partial academic studies already completed with the related legalised Italian translation, or, if in possession of the degree, send a certified copy of the qualification, with a declaration of value on the spot and relative legalised Italian translation) and/or an abbreviation of the degree course.

- **Declaration of Value** of the qualification, issued by the competent Italian Embassy or Consulate in the country where you obtained your secondary school qualification
- certification of knowledge of the Italian language at least B2 level of the CEFR (*Common European Framework of Reference for the knowledge of languages*), not required for those who are Italian native speakers; if you do not have a certification you will have to follow a **supplementary course** ("Linguistic insights") during the course of study

Scholarships

Scholarships for the degree course in Italian language and culture

It is possible to apply for a scholarship to partially cover enrolment fees for the Degree Course in Italian Language and Culture. To submit the application, the candidate must be in possession of all the requirements required for enrolment in the degree course.

Partial coverage of enrolment fees with tutoring

The ICoN Consortium offers **10 semester-based scholarships** to partially **cover the registration fees with tutoring** in the first semester of the Degree Course, reserved for foreign and Italian citizens provided they reside abroad and meet the requirements for enrolment in the Italian university.

The winners will have to pay a fee of €450 (instead of €900) and will also be able to take advantage of a free online course of Italian ICoN level B2 in self-learning.

Partial coverage of self-learning enrolment fees

The ICoN Consortium offers **10 semester-based scholarships** to partially **cover the enrolment fees** for self-learning in the first semester of the Degree Course, reserved for foreign and Italian citizens provided they reside abroad and meet the requirements for enrolment in the Italian university.

The winners will have to pay a fee of 300 euros (instead of 600 euros) and will also be able to take advantage of a free online course of Italian ICoN level B2 in self-learning.

MERIT CRITERIA FOR THE DEGREE COURSE ICoN

The ICoN Consortium offers a reduction in the fees in tutoring (700 euros instead of 900) and in self-study (330 euro instead of 600) to cover the registration fees.

This reduction will be applied to the student re-enrolment fee according to these criteria:

Or 10 exams with an average of not less than 24/30
11 exams with an average of not less than 23/30
12 exams with an average of not less than 22/30
13 exams with an average of not less than 21/30
14 exams with an average of not less than 20/30 etc.
- at least **12 exams** with an average of not less than 25/30 for those who enrol in the third year, second semester
Or 13 exams with an average of not less than 24/30
14 exams with an average of not less than 23/30
15 exams with an average of not less than 22/30
16 exams with an average of not less than 21/30
17 exams with an average of not less than 20/30 etc.

NB: with exams we mean complete exams with credit acquisition and not partial tests

Any exams recognised for the abbreviation of the degree course will also be calculated.

The student can personally perform the mathematical average of the marks and check whether he falls within the parameters of merit.

It is not necessary to make a written request: those who meet the merit criteria will find the fee in the procedure reduced.
